It was standing room only at St. David's Episcopal Church In Roland Park Tuesday night.

The community staged a rally to voice their concern over plans to build a retirement community on 18 acres of green space owned by the Baltimore Country Club.

Members of the club are considering a proposal to sell the land off Falls Road to Keswick for 12 million dollars.

While no formal action has been outlined by the community, Tuesday night's meeting made it clear residents will oppose a zoning change that would allow the development to go forward.

The community says it has tried to buy the land repeatedly over the years, but their offers have been ignored.
