



Ciclovía VI: From Park to Park

Baltimore, MD, May 5, 2016

The [Roland Park Civic League](#) and Baltimore City [BMore Streets for People Program](#) will host a sixth ciclovía on Sunday, May 22, 2016, from noon to 4 p.m.

In this “Park to Park,” car-free event, vehicular traffic will be diverted from southbound Roland Avenue and West University Parkway, as well as Tudor Arms Avenue, Beech Avenue and Wyman Park Drive. This will allow participants to bike, skate or walk a three-mile course from Roland Park to Druid Hill Park.

Also collaborating in this second such multi-neighborhood ciclovía are [Friends of Druid Hill Park](#), the Rolde, Hoes Heights, Wyman Park, Hampden and Remington neighborhood associations, [Bike Maryland](#), the City of Baltimore and [Johns Hopkins University](#).

Local bike shops will be on hand during the ciclovía to tune bikes along the course. Bike rodeos will teach safe riding techniques to younger children. Demonstrations will be held of the electric pedal-assisted bikes, soon to be offered through Baltimore’s new [Bike Share Program](#).

Through its BMore Streets for People Program, Baltimore is one of scores of cities worldwide developing [ciclovía programs](#). More than a thousand people of all ages have participated in each of the five previous Baltimore ciclovías.
