Standing Rules

May 22, 2018

- 1. The Chair will announce the appointed parliamentarian for the Annual Meeting, and assign one member to serve as timekeeper, and two members to serve as tellers (i.e., vote counters).
- 2. Members must be recognized by the Chair before speaking. The member requesting recognition shall first state their name and Roland Park street.
- 3. Each member, when recognized in debate, may speak up to five minutes (per the bylaws) provided that there remains time left for the business item set forth in the agenda.
- 4. The proposed agenda and these standing rules will control the order and handling of business in the Annual Meeting.
- 5. The reading of officer and committee reports may be dispensed with or abbreviated, since copies of the visually-presented reports will generally be made available at the meeting, and/or at the Roland Park Civic League's office following the Annual Meeting, and/or be posted on the League's website.
- 6. Although only members have the right to speak and vote, the Chair may choose to recognize non-member community attendees, time permitting.
