



Autumn 2020 * Roland Park Free Tree Program

Fifty trees will be arriving mid-October to plant throughout Roland Park in the fall installment of the *Roland Park Landscape Committee's Free Tree Program*. Residents who are up to date with Civic League and Roads & Maintenance dues are eligible to request and pick-up a free tree for planting on their personal property. The trees will arrive in one and three gallon pot, sizes that are easy to carry and plant, a great family project.

Due to ongoing COVID concerns, large trees that require professional planting are limited and are by preorder only. Large trees for fall planting in the verge or streetscape have already been reserved and those homeowners will get an email in October about planting.

Native Dogwood

PawPaw

Black Gum

American Plum

Swamp White Oak

Eastern cottonwood
